




"You have a little mouth; soft like powder; she says good things; beautiful like a flower".



"The kisses on the mouth when you grow up you're gonna give the grown ups don't touch it they must respect".






"Listen to what I say and repeat it again I don't listen or look at you if you don't treat me well".




Bravi sings to you:

"With my mouth I will say cheerful words I will never a ever scream just for happiness and joy".






"I have two beautiful hands that God gave me with love with them I'm going to give always the best."

For many years I experienced domestic violence at home. I saw my father repeatedly hit my mother. I remember that I would run to hide under my bed and then my mother would take us to my grandparents'. A place I call "Love's Haven". Being there I understood that what I was living at home was very bad and that this was not the way a family should be.

I began to reject the father figure, and to get away from my mother for continuing to live in a place like that. I also began to build a strong character that protected me and at the same time I became a cold and difficult child.

And you know what? It hurt in my soul and it took us a long time to rebuild a new peaceful home. There are always wounds when you grow up that are soften, healed and forgiven working little by little from your inner self to rebuild your identity and return to your true essence as the wonderful and unique human being you are.

But not everyone succeeds. There are millions of people in the world walking around with wounds from their past and carrying the weight of abuse inside their homes, repeating stories of violence from generation to generation and abusing in different ways those around them.

What do you decide now?

I invite you to use your mouth to bless, not to hurt.

I invite you to use your hands to embrace, not to abuse others.

I invite you to use your feet to play with your children, with your family and not to hurt them. God always gives us a new day to do things much better.

Never admit less than love and respect. Never silence when you are abused. Never think you deserve to be abused. Talk, get help, you're never alone.

You want a better world? Build it EN CASA, that's where it all starts!
